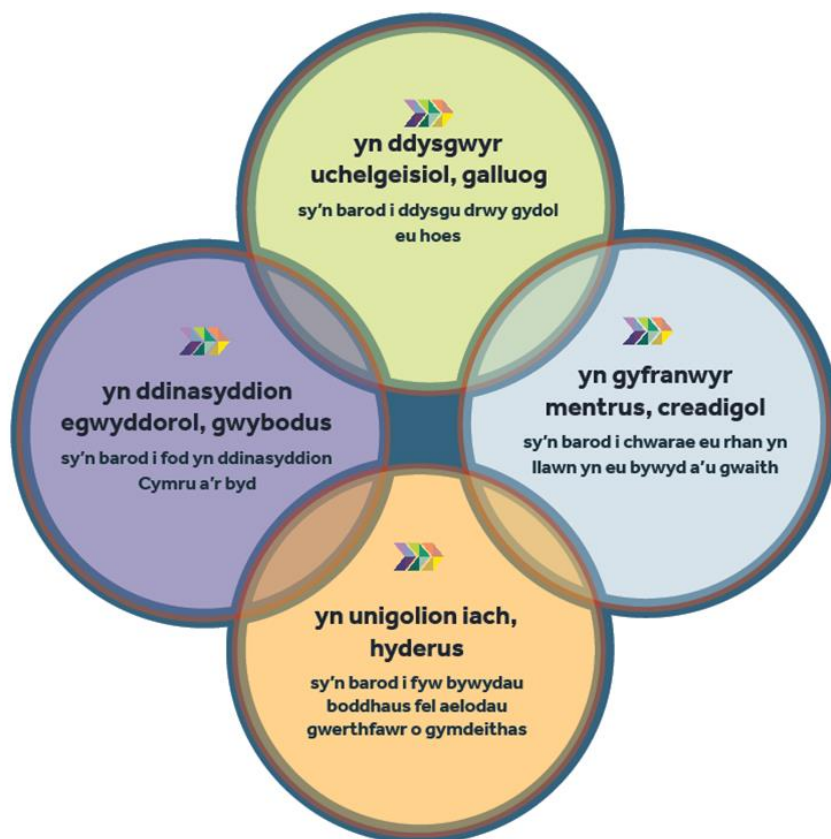
Rhagair

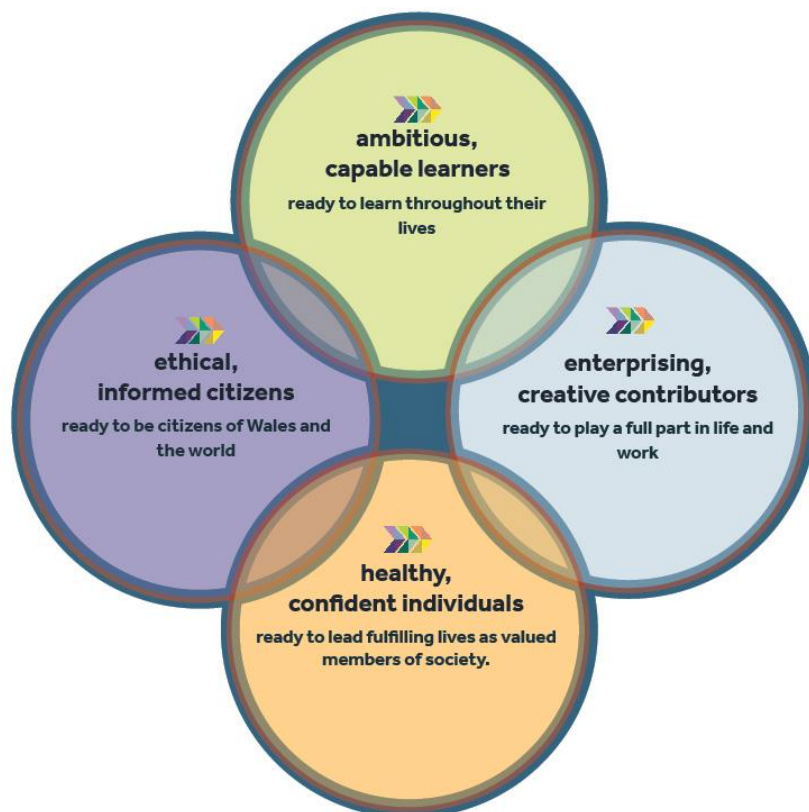
Foreword

It gives me great pleasure to present to you via this handbook, some information about the Nursery Class here in Ysgol Gymraeg Bryn-y-Môr.

Your child is about to embark on his/her educational journey and we wish to make the transition from home to school as smooth as possible. We endeavour to ensure this by achieving the aims below.

Our Aims:

- To provide a safe, caring and stimulating environment in which your child can learn and develop.
- To provide a happy, pleasurable and fun environment, which allows children to be children and build relationships with each other.
- To provide a relevant, broad and balanced curriculum with the ethos of the four purposes at the heart of the curricular choices.



- To develop your child's independence and well being
- To establish a good relationship between the school and parents

We consider this period to be of utmost importance in your child's life. This is the period when the foundations are set for the future.

If you as parents are not able to speak Welsh, don't worry! As a result of being immersed in the language from a young age the soon become fluent. The ability to speak another language opens the door to another culture. This can appreciate the diversity of the world in which we live. Research shows that children that speak more than one language can think more creatively and flexibly, are better at problem solving and perform better in tests.

Two languages- twice the choice and opportunities!

Before Starting School

There are many ways that you can support your child's development:

- Give your child the opportunity to socialise with others, to learn to play and share e.g. join a playgroup such as Cylch Tî a Fî
- Read stories to her/him.
- Sing nursery rhymes, songs and counting rhymes together
- Speak and listen to your child
- Include your child in everyday activities e.g. tidying up, cooking, shopping, matching socks/shoes
- Count everyday objects
- Watch Welsh programmes on S4C - Cyw
- Play games on the computer or iPad
- Encourage your child to go to the toilet independently, flush the toilet and wash and dry their hands
- Encourage your child to dress independently
- Encourage your child to recognise their name
- Talk to your child to prepare him/her for starting school
- Bring your child to visit the classroom and the staff. (Your child will receive an invitation with a date for your visit in the welcome pack.)

Ewch drwy'r giât ar waelod yr lard i hebrwng eich plentyn i'r dosbarth. Fe fydd staff y Meithrin yn y dosbarth o 8:40y.b. i groesawu'r plant.

Sesiwn Prynhawn:

Bydd aelod o staff yn croesawu eich plentyn wrth y giât ar waelod yr lard Fawr ond mae croeso i chi hebrwng eich plentyn, yn arbennig ar ddechrau ei g/chyfnod yn y Meithrin.

Prydlondeb ac Absenoldebau

Mae'n bwysig i sicrhau bod eich plentyn yn cyrraedd ysgol ar amser ac yn cael ei g/chasglu yn brydlon. (Rhaid llofnodi'r Llyfr Hwyr yn y Swyddfa os ydych yn hwyr.)

Os ydy eich plentyn yn absennol, a wnewch chi roi wybod i'r ysgol mor gynted â phosib naill ai drwy ffonio, neu drwy ebostio'r ysgol.

Casglu Disgyblion

Gofynnir i chi hysbysu'r ysgol o enwau'r oedolion sydd â hawl i gasglu eich plentyn o'r ysgol drwy gwblhau ffurflen briodol.

Rhowch wybod i'r ysgol os ydy trefniadau casglu'ch plentyn ar ddiwedd y sesiwn yn newid.

Nid ydym yn rhyddhau plentyn i ofal oedolyn arall os nad ydym wedi ein hysbysu ymlaen llaw bod newid i'r trefniadau hynny.

Gofal Iechyd/Meddygînîaeth

Rhowch wybod i ni am unrhyw glefyd, afiechyd neu alergedd sydd ar eich plentyn.

Byddwn yn ddiolchgar petaech yn ceisio amseru meddygînîaeth o gwmpas oriau'r ysgol. Os nad yw hwn yn bosib, mae croeso i chi ddod i'r ysgol i roi'r moddion i'ch plentyn neu i alw yn y swyddfa i lenwi ffurflen feddygînîaeth. Ni fydd unrhyw feddygînîaeth yn cael ei gweinyddu heb gwblhau'r ffurflen hon.

Gwisg Ysgol

Mae gwisg ysgol swyddogol gan yr ysgol. Does dim gorfodaeth ei gwisgo'n ddyddiol er bod llawer yn gwneud felly, ond disgwylir i bawb ymdrechu i'w gwisgo i gyngherddau neu gyfarfodydd arbennig. (Gweler Prospectws yr Ysgol)

Rydyn yn defnyddio'r iard fach beth bynnag yw'r tywydd, felly'n mae'n bwysig bod y plant wedi'u gwisgo'n addas.

Fe fydd angen cot, menig a het yn ystod y gaeaf a het haul yn ystod y tywydd poeth.

Esgidiau Glaw

Pan fydd hi'n bwrw glaw fe fydd angen pâr o esgidiau glaw ar eich plentyn. Gellir prynu pâr i'w ddefnyddio yn yr ysgol neu adael rhai yn yr ysgol yn ystod yr wythnos.

Addysg Gorfforol

Fe fydd eich plentyn yn cymryd rhan mewn gwersi Addysg Gorfforol yn wythnosol. A wnewch chi sicrhau ei fod e/ei bod hi'n gwisgo jogys du ac esgidiau ymarfer ar y diwrnodau yma. Rhennir gwybodaeth am y diwrnodau ar ddechrau'r flwyddyn addysgol.

Ffrwythau a Llaeth

Rydyn yn ceisio hybu bwyta'n iach yma'n Ysgol Gymraeg Bryn-y-Môr. Rydwn felly'n gwerthu ffrwythau amrywiol bob dydd. Cost y ffrwythau yw £1 yr wythnos. Cewch dalu am ffrwyth yn wythnosol neu'n dymhorol wrth osod yr arian/siec mewn amlen gydag enw, dosbarth eich plentyn ac 'Arian Ffrwyth' wedi'i ysgrifennu'n glir arni. Cesglir arian ffrwyth ar ddydd Llun.

Mae Amser Byrbryd yn gyfle hyfryd i gymdeithasu gyda ffrindiau, dysgu am hylendid personol a blasu rhywbeth newydd.

Darperir llaeth yn ddyddiol i bob plentyn yn y Cyfnod Sylfaen ar draws Cymru. Nid oes rhaid talu amdano.

Byddwch yn amyneddgar! Rhowch ddigon o amser i'ch plentyn gyfarwyddo â'r ysgol. Gall yr amser hyn amrywio o blentyn i blentyn.

Yn ystod y diwrnodau cyntaf, mae'n debygol y bydd rhai plant yn ddagreuol ac mae hynny'n naturiol. Os yw eich plentyn yn anhapus, mae croeso i chi gysylltu â'r ysgol er mwyn tawelu eich meddwl a gwirio ei bod/fod wedi setlo. Os oes unrhywbeth yn eich poeni neu os oes gennych unrhyw gwestiynau, fe fydd yr athrawes ddosbarth yn hapus i geisio helpu. Yr amser orau i drafod gyda'r athrawes yw cyn i'r sesiwn ddechrau neu ar ddiwedd y sesiwn.

Starting School

Nursery Hours

Morning Session: 8:50– 11:20a.m.

Afternoon Session: 1:00–3:20p.m.

Morning Session:

Enter at the gate on the Yard and escort your child to the classroom. Nursery staff will be ready to welcome the children from 8:40a.m. onwards.

Afternoon Session:

A member of staff will welcome your child at the gate on the Yard. You're welcome to escort your child to the Small Yard if you wish, especially at the beginning of his/her time in Nursery.

Punctuality and Absences

It is important to ensure that your child arrives on time and is collected promptly. (You must sign the Late Book in the office if you are late.)

Please inform the school of any change in arrangements regarding the collection of your child at the end of the session.

In the case of absence, please inform the school at the earliest opportunity either by telephone or emailing the school.

Collecting pupils

You will be asked to complete a form informing the school of the names of adults authorised to collect your child. Please inform the school of any change in arrangements regarding the collection of your child at the end of the session.

We do not release a child into another adult's care if we have not been notified beforehand of a change to the usual arrangement.

Health Care/Medicines

You will need to inform us if your child suffers from any ill health, disease or allergy.

We would appreciate it if you try timing medication around school hours.

If this is not possible, you are welcome to come to school to give your child the medication yourself or call into the office to fill out a medication form.

Staff will not administer medication without completing this form.

School Uniform

There is an official school uniform, the daily wearing of which is optional.

However, on special occasions or stage performances, uniformity of dress is required. (See the School Prospectus)

The school uniform may be purchased locally at:

- Nash Sports, Sketty
- J & S Leisurewear, Ty Coch
- Bergoni, Llansamlet

All article of clothing, bag and other belonging should be marked with the child's name so that mislaid items can be recovered easily.

Dressing Suitably for the Weather

Whatever the weather, we use the Little Yard, therefore it is important that your child is suitably dressed.

S/he will need a coat, gloves and hat in winter months and a sun hat when the weather improves.

REMEMBER TO APPLY SUN LOTION BEFORE COMING TO SCHOOL.

Wellies

Your child will need a pair of wellies for rainy days. You may wish to buy a pair to use at school or just leave them in school during the week.

Physical Education

Your child will participate in weekly PE lessons. Please ensure that she/he is wearing black joggers and trainers on these days. Information regarding the

days will be given at the beginning of the academic year.

Fruit and Milk

We endeavour to promote healthy eating here in Ysgol Gymraeg Bryn-y-Môr. We therefore sell a variety of fruits every day. The cost is £1 a week. This can be paid weekly or termly by placing the money/cheque in an envelope with your child's name, class and 'Fruit Money' written clearly on it. Fruit Money is collected on Mondays.

Snack time is a great opportunity to socialise with friends, to learn about personal hygiene and try something new.

Milk is provided free of charge for every child in the Foundation Phase across Wales.

Be patient! Allow sufficient time for your child to settle in at school. This time can vary from child to child.

Naturally, some children will be tearful during the first few days and we appreciate that it can also be an anxious time for parents. You are very welcome therefore, to contact the school to check that your child has settled and to put your mind at rest.

If you have any general worries or questions, the class teacher will do her best to help. Staff are busy during the school day therefore the best time to talk with the teacher is before the session begins or at the end of the session.

Fe fydd cyfle i'ch plentyn i archwilio i h/amgylchedd dysgu a dysgu sgiliau newydd yn ogystal â datblygu sgiliau mae eisioes wedi'i h/ennill.

Fe fydd chwarae addysgol gweithredol yn cefnogi ei d/ddysgu ar draws y chwe Maes Dysgu sef:

Datblygiad Personol a Chymdeithasol, Lles ac Amrywiaeth Ddiwylliannol

Bydd eich plentyn yn dysgu amdano/i ei hunain a'i b/pherthynas ag eraill. Caiff ei h/annog i ddatblygu ei hunan-barch, ei g/chredoau p/ersonol a'i g/werthoedd moesol. Bydd yn datblygu dealltwriaeth bod gan bobl eraill anghenion, galluedd, creodau a safonyntiau gwahanol.

Fe fydd gweithgareddau yn cynnwys mynegi teimladau, gweithio/chwarae ar y cyd, siarad am yr hyn sydd yn dda/ddrwg, yn gywir/anghywir, yn deg/annheg, trafod dathladiadu, gofalu am yr amgylchedd.

Sgiliau Iaith, Llythrennedd a Chyfathrebu

Mae'r datblygiad a'r defnydd o iaith a chyfathrebu yn holl bwysig i ddysgu plant ifanc. Fe fydd pwyslais ar ddatblygu sgiliau gwranddo a siarad i osod sylfeini cadarn ar gyfer darllen ac ysgrifennu.

Fe fydd gweithgareddau'n cynnwys, chwarae rôl, mwynhau llyfrau, canu, chwarae gemau, gwneud marcïau ac ysgrifennu cynnar.

Datblygiad Mathemategol

Bydd eich plentyn yn cyfrif, didoli a chyfateb gwrthrychau, yn datblygu ei dd/dealltwriaeth o iaith fathemategol mewn cyd-destun, yn archwilio a

chreu patrymau, yn dechrau archwilio priodweddau siapiau ac yn datblygu ei dd/dealltwriaeth o fesurau.

Fe fydd y gweithgareddau'n ymarferol iawn ac yn cynnwys chwarae gemau, chwarae rôl a chanu rhigymanu rhif.

Gwybodaeth a Dealltwriaeth o'r Byd

Fe fydd eich plentyn yn dysgu'r sgiliau, gwybodaeth a'r dealltwriaeth hanfodol sydd angen arno/i i wneud synnwyr o'r byd, h.y. i ddechrau deall digwyddiadau'r gorffennol, pobl a lleoedd, pethau byw, a'r gwaith mae pobl yn ei wneud.

Fe fydd y gweithgareddau'n cynnwys defnyddio'u synhwyrau, archwilio, arbrofi, gofyn cwestiynau, coginio, plannu.

Datblygiad Corfforol

Fe fydd eich plentyn yn datblygu ei sgiliau cydsymud, ei g/chydbwysedd, ei rheolaeth, ei sgiliau echddygol bras a manwl, a'i sgiliau llawdrinol.

Fe fydd gweithgareddau'n cynnwys rhedeg, neidio, sgipio, reidio beiciau, taflu a dal offer mawr a bach, defnyddio siswrn, tynnu lluniau, peintio, sialco, chwarae gyda chlai/toes.

Datblygiad Creadigol

Mae creadigrwydd yn hanfodol i ddysgu llwyddiannus. Mae bod yn greadigol yn galluogi plant i wneud cysylltiadau rhwng y meysydd dysgu ac felly'n ymestyn eu dealltwriaeth.

Mae'r maes yn cynnwys gweithgareddau fel peintio, tynnu lluniau, dylunio a gwneud modelau, arbrofi, canu, gwrando ar a chreu cerddoriaeth, dawnsio a chwarae rôl.

Ymhlyg â'r cwricwlwm Cyfnod Sylfaen rhoddir pwyslais ar ddatblygu sgiliau ar draws y cwricwlwm. Bydd eich plentyn yn cael ei h/annog i gaffael, datblygu ymarfer a chymhwyso sgiliau meddwl, llythrennedd, cymhwysedd digidol a rhifedd ar draws y cwricwlwm. Trwy ddatblygu ei sgiliau ar draws y cwricwlwm bydd yn datblygu'n ddysgwr annibynnol a chyd-ddibynnol.

The Foundation Phase

"The Foundation Phase curriculum aims to excite and stimulate children's learning, improve their attainment and to secure the best possible start for all children in Wales." (Making Provision for Outdoor Learning- Cardiff Council Schools and Lifelong Learning Service, Cardiff Advisory Service for Education)

The curriculum and environment will be planned and structured to enable your child to be an active learner.

Your child will have the opportunity to explore his/her learning environment and to learn new skills in addition to developing skills previously acquired.

Active educational play supports your child's learning across the six Areas of Learning:

Personal and Social Development, Well-Being and Cultural Diversity

Your child will learn about himself/herself, his/her relationships with others. He/she will be encouraged to develop his/her self-esteem, personal beliefs and moral values. He/she will develop an understanding that others have differing needs, abilities, beliefs and views.

Activities include expressing feelings, working/playing together, talking about what is good/bad, right/wrong, fair/unfair, discussing celebrations, caring for the environment.

Language, Literacy and Communication Skills

The development and use of communication and language is at the heart of young children's learning. Emphasis will be on developing speaking and listening skills to lay sound foundations for reading and writing.

Activities include rôle play, enjoying books, singing, playing games, making marks and pre-writing.

Mathematical Development

Your child will count, sort and match objects. He/she will develop his/her understanding of mathematical language in context, explore and create patterns, will begin to explore the properties of shape and develop his/her

understanding of measures. Activities will be very practical and include playing games, rôle play, and singing number rhymes.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

Your child will learn the crucial knowledge, skills and understanding to help him/her make sense of the world, i.e. to start to understand past events, people and places, living things and the work people do.

Activities include using their senses, exploring, experimenting, asking questions, cooking, planting.

Physical Development

Your child will be developing their coordination, their balance, their control, their gross and fine motor skills, and his/her manipulative skills.

Activities include running, jumping, skipping, riding bikes, throwing and catching large and small apparatus, cutting, pencil control, painting, chalking, handling malleable materials

Creative Development

Creativity is fundamental to successful learning. Being creative enables children to make connections between one area of learning and another, and so extending their understanding.

Activities include painting, drawing, modelling, experimenting, singing, listening to and making music, dance and imaginative play.

As well as the Foundation Phase curriculum, emphasis is put on developing skills across the curriculum. Your child will be encouraged to acquire, develop, practice and apply thinking, communication, digital competency and numeracy skills across the curriculum. By developing their skills across the curriculum, they will become independent and interdependent learners.
