It's planning time!

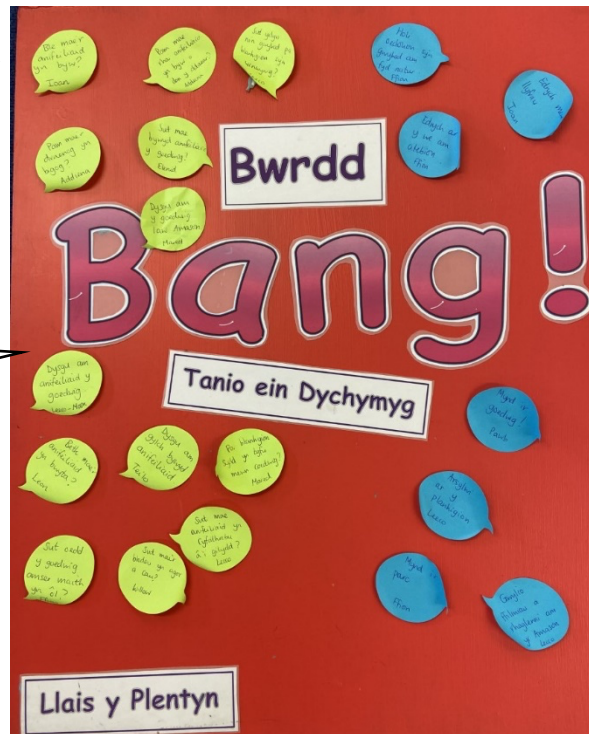
