Health and Wellbeing

- Develop ball handling skills.
- Develop athletic skills and enjoy preparing towards sports day.
- Enjoy working as a team.

The Expressive Arts

Science and Technology

- Enjoy observing and asking questions about the forest habitat.
- Understand that our actions can have an impact on the environment and living things.
- Enjoy exploring the relationship between living things, their habitats and life cycles.

The Humanities

- Learn about the forest habitat in Wales and what lives and grows there.
- Compare the characteristics of a forest in Wales and a rainforest.
- Develop an understanding of the impact of people on the natural world.
- Develop an awareness of how we can care for living things and the environment.
- Understand what 'Fair Trade' is and that our actions have an impact on communities and the environment.
- Learn to appreciate the beauty and wonder of the natural world and enjoy reading 'The Baby Birds', a traditional Muslim story.
