Expressive Arts

- Explore a range of musical instruments.
- Learn how to use percussion instruments.
- Enjoy singing a range of songs.
- Respond to music – learn about simple musical elements
- Learn about famous musicians from Wales.
- Enjoy planning, rehearsing and performing for an audience.
- Evaluate and reflect upon our work and performance.

Health and Wellbeing

- Explore our feelings by listening and responding to music.
- Develop our fitness by dancing.
- Understand that music can have an impact on our mental wellbeing.
- Develop our confidence by performing for others.
- Understand how to stay safe online.

Science and Technology

- How sound is created and how it comes from a range of sources.
- Explore how sound travels in simple terms.
- Create a musical instrument using a variety of materials.
- Discuss the characteristics of materials whilst sorting and grouping instruments.
- Communicate our ideas through a variety of digital methods, including composing music.

Languages, Literacy and Communication

- Create a 'Music Studio' role-play corner and enjoy composing, experimenting and listening to music.
- Read and listen to a variety of stories.
- Continue to develop our reading skills.
- Learn about rhyme and alliteration.
- Write for a variety of purposes, including writing poetry that rhymes.
- Continue to practise our spelling skills and learn to form letters correctly.

The homework will be shared through your child's Hwb account. See the instructions on the class page on the school website. There will be mathematics homework on Thursday or Friday evenings. There will be a short list of words to learn on a Friday and a spelling test will be given on the following Friday. (Yr2)

Mathematics and Numeracy

- Practise and improve our addition, subtraction, division and multiplication skills.
- Use money, measure mass and continue to learn to tell the time.
- Develop our mental mathematical skills.
- Learn how to organise and use data.

- Learn about the importance of Welsh music, dances, songs, poetry and the Eisteddfod.



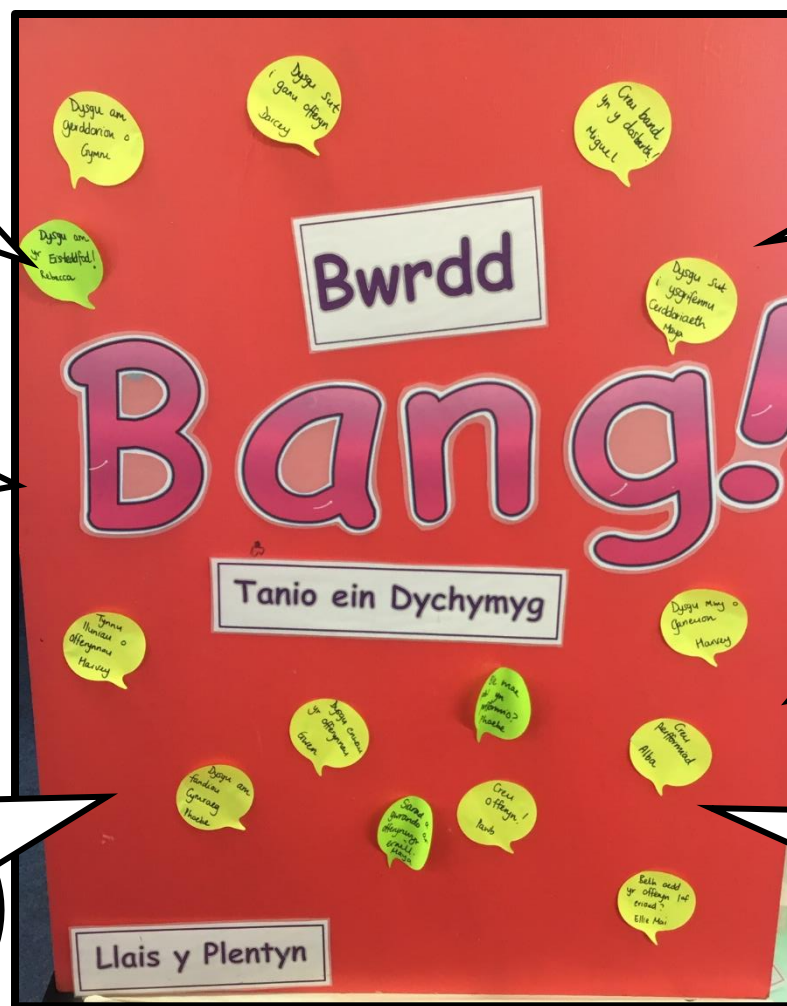
