Expressive Arts

- Enjoy a weekly music session with a peripatetic teacher.
- Study the work of local artists and concentrate on studying landscapes.
- Enjoy developing our drawing and printing skills and emulate the work and style of local artist Sarah Hopkins.
- Create various presentations and films.
- Enjoy singing a variety of songs.

Science and Technology

- Develop our fine-motor skills through a variety of tasks.
- Enjoy new and exciting experiences in the outdoor learning environment of the Forest School.
- Discuss school rules and develop an understanding of how to become responsible citizens.
- Understand our role and responsibilities within the Brynmill community.
- Discuss our feelings and think about the way we treat others.
- Make decisions about our work, as individuals and as part of a group.
