Dear parent/guardian,

We are very fortunate to be able to offer 'Forest School' sessions this year for all Year 1 and 2 pupils. During the year, your child will have a regular opportunity to take part in forest school activities which will be led by forest school leaders. The activities will take place at Singleton park.

Research shows that the process and nature of a Forest School experience and wider outdoor learning can bring many benefits to participants including:

- increased physical and mental health and wellbeing
- emotional literacy
- confidence and self-esteem
- communication skills
- group work
- problem solving
- greater knowledge and understanding of self, community and the natural environment.

The sessions will be held on Thursdays. Half the class will take part during the morning, and the other half during the afternoon. Here is the timetable for this term:
