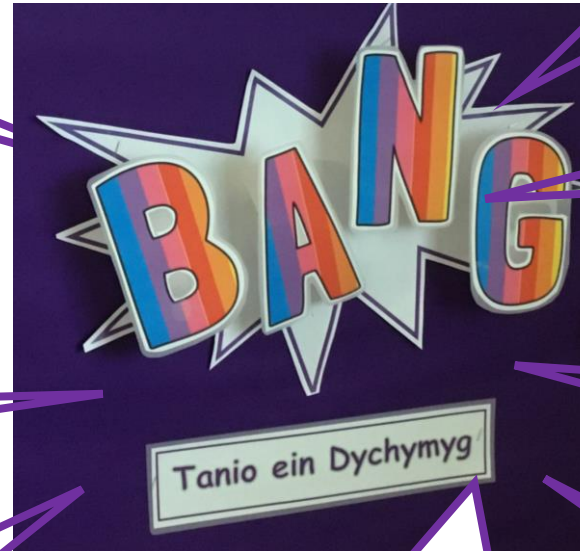

Here are some of our ideas.

Expressive Arts

- Look at and imitate the work of Mary Lloyd Jones
- Practise our drawing and painting skills with different colours
- Experiment with mixing colours
- Explore and experiment with a variety of techniques, materials, processes, resources, tools
- Enjoy singing familiar and new songs
- Take part in the *Pori Drwy Stori* Rhyme Challenge

Health and Well-being

- Express likes and dislikes
- Express our feelings and show awareness of other people's feelings
- Learn how to keep safe whilst crossing the road
- Practise our hand-eye coordination, gross motor and fine motor skills
- Identify the people who look after us and keep us safe
- Remember times when people have shown us kindness and think of how we can be kind to others

Humanities

- Show an awareness of how we are similar and different from others
- Be curious about the world around us
- Think about who are the important people in our lives and why they are important to us e.g. family
- Identify places which are important to us and begin to recognise places that are familiar to us
- Learn about Diwali and Christmas traditions and why Christmas is important to Christians

Language, Literacy and Communication

- Play games to develop concentration skills
- Create a 'Three Bears' Cottage' role-play area
- Listen to stories and poetry related to our big idea
- Learn vocabulary and songs about our big idea
- Tric a Chlic activities
- Express ourselves through mark making, drawing pictures and emergent writing
- Enjoy writing for a variety of purposes e.g. descriptive writing, invitations, lists and cards.

Mathematics and Numeracy

- Develop our understanding of mathematical language through role-play and playing games
- Sing songs and reciting number rhymes
- Count, read, write and order numbers
- Develop our adding and subtraction skills
- Sort objects, collect and present data about favourite colours
- Investigate measure, shape, money and pattern
- Solve simple practical problems

Science and Technology

- Investigate our environment, make observations and express thoughts about the colours around us
- Show inquisitiveness and question how to make a rainbow
- Observe the world through coloured glasses
- Investigate forces using toy cars
- Use a variety of computing equipment safely
- Develop our coding skills by giving a series of instructions to a programmable toy
- Design, make and evaluate a Christmas decoration
