Languages, Literacy and Communication

- Develop our our reading skills in English and Welsh and enjoy listening to a variety of stories and poems.
- Continue to practise our spelling and handwriting skills.
- Improve our verbal skills in English and Welsh.
- Learn about alliteration and rhyme
- Write for a variety of purposes, including poetry that uses rhyme

Mathematics and Numeracy

- Read and halve 3-digit multiples of 100.
- Understand place value and partition 3-digit numbers.
- Doubling 3-digit numbers.
- Practice counting, reading, writing and organising numbers up to 1000.
- Practice and improve our addition, subtraction, division and a multiply.
- Use money, practice length measurement skills and continue to learn to read the clock
