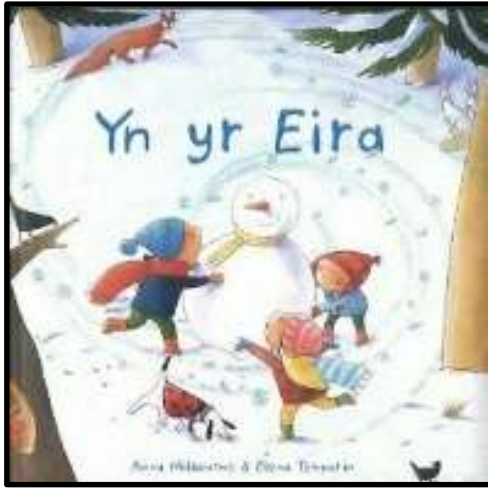




Help for parents
