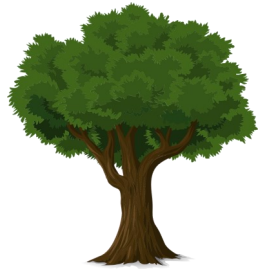


Summer Term (ii) 2019 - Blwyddyn 1 a 2
