Language, Literacy and Communication Skills

- Continue to practise our spelling and handwriting skills.

Creative Development

- Study the music used to portray superheroes in cartoons or films.
- Compose our own music to portray superheroes.
- Develop our creative movement skills by dancing to superhero music.

- Practise counting, recognising, writing and organising numbers to at least 100.
- Practise and develop our addition and subtraction skills and counting in steps.
- Use money, practise measuring weight and develop our problem solving skills.
