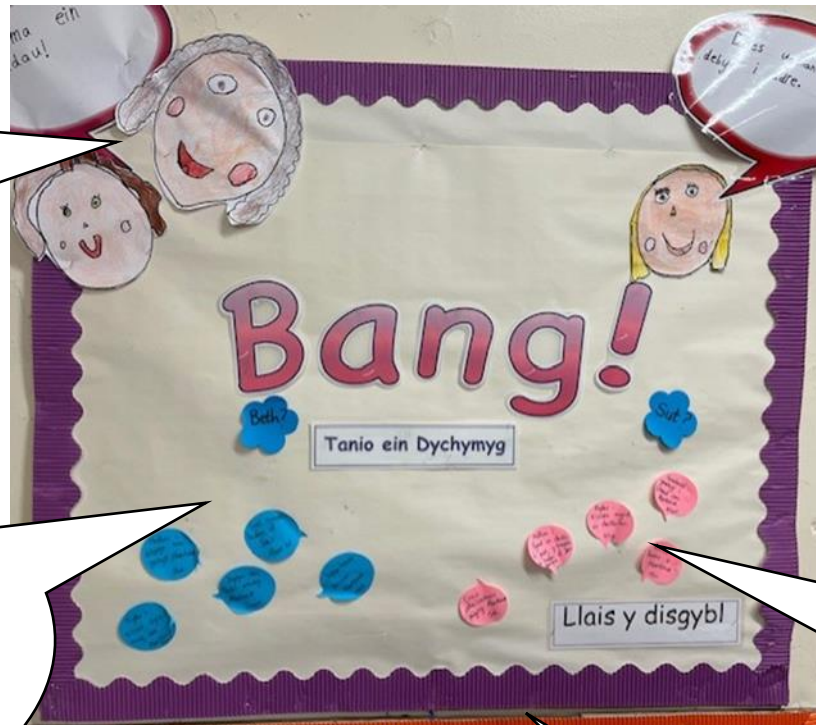

- Continue to practise our spelling and handwriting skills.

Health and Wellbeing

Continue to develop our fitness and improve our gymnastic skills.

Practice and develop our fine-motor skills.

Enjoy new experiences during Forest School sessions and various visits.

Discuss school rules and how to be responsible citizens.

Understand our roles and responsibilities within the Swansea community.

Discuss our feelings and how others should be treated.

Make decisions about our work, both as individuals and as a member of a group.
