## Language, Literacy and Communication

### Oracy

Discussing with and presenting information about what has been learned to others.  
Presenting using the green screen eg. an interview with a Celt / a Roman.

### Reading

Reading information about our theme and comprehending.  
Reading as widely as possible for pleasure.  
Our class novel 'Diwrnod Ofnadwy'.

### Writing

Enjoying writing for different purposes eg. presenting information, diary, letter, poem.

## Mathematics and Numeracy

### Mathematics

Place value  
Addition and subtraction  
Times tables up to six  
Halving and doubling  
Using money  
Length, perimeter and area  
Time – telling the time to the nearest five minutes.

### Numeracy

Using the four rules to solve problems in the context of our theme.  
Creating a 'Roman Feast' spreadsheet.  
Creating a timeline.  
Calculating perimeter and area using a villa plan.  
Sorting the planets using different criteria.  
Describing where location using the eight points of the compass.

## Science and technology

### Science

Studying the Solar System and learning about the planets.

Looking at the different phases of the moon.  
Gravity. Why do things 'float' in space?

### Digital Competency

Creating a database about the planets.  
Creating and using spreadsheets to solve problems re 'A Roman Feast'.  
Word processing skills.  
Using a green screen to create a short film.

### Design and Technology

Creating a shield.  
Designing jewellery.

### Food Technology

Designing a Celtic or Roman meal for a feast.

### Personal and Social Education

Looking at how we should respect one another and how our actions affect others.  
Our rights.

### Physical Education

Netball, football and badminton during games lessons (second half of the term)  
Gymnastics and dance (first half of the term)

## Expressive Arts

### Art

Decorating a shield.  
Creating a mosaic.  
Creating clay tiles and / or thumb pots and decorating them.  
Creating Celtic knots and printing them.

### Cerddoriaeth

Listening to 'The Planets' by Holst and discussing the music.  
Consolidating knowledge of the notes already learned on the recorder and learning E, D and F.

### Drama

Roleplay – 'Red Chair' activities.  
Creating a presentation – an interview with a Roman / Celt.

## Humanities

### History

Defining History.  
Creating a timeline.  
Studying the Celtic way of life and the changes brought by the Romans.

### Geography

Looking at direction.  
Studying maps to trace where the Romans went.  
Calculating distance simply on a map between some of the important towns during Roman times.

### Religious Education

Looking at and comparing the Christian and Muslim faiths.
