Knowledge and Understanding of the World

- Learn about the Sikh religion 'Naming Ceremony'

Physical Development

- Practise and develop our gymnastic skills.
- Practise our fine motor skills in our 'busy fingers' area.

Creative Development

- Study the work of a famous artist, e.g. Van Gogh
- Practise and develop our artistic skills whilst creating portraits using a variety of techniques and suitable computer software.
- Learn to sing new songs and use simple percussion instruments as an accompaniment to the music.
