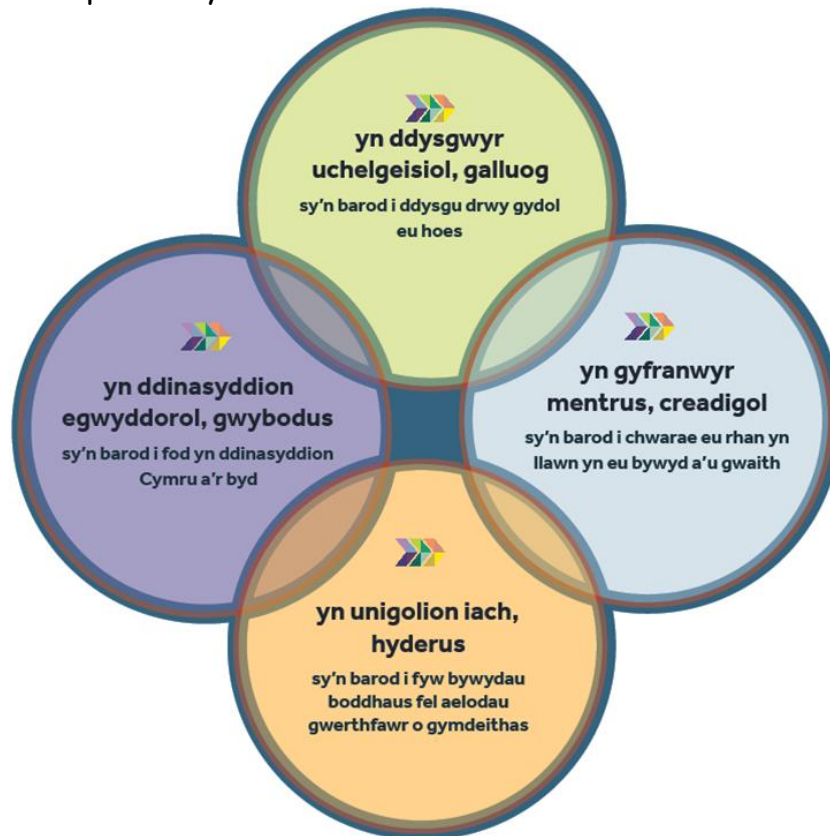
Rhagair

Foreword

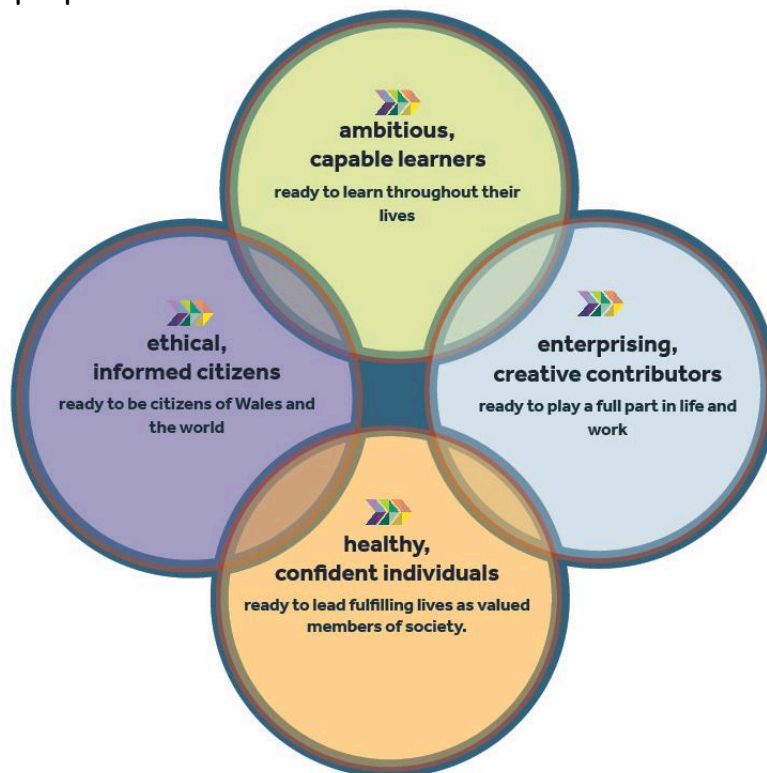
It gives me great pleasure to present to you via this handbook, some information about the Nursery Class here in Ysgol Gymraeg Bryn-y-Môr.

Your child is about to embark on his/her educational journey and we wish to make the transition from home to school as smooth as possible. We endeavour to ensure this by achieving the aims below.

Our Aims:

To provide a safe, caring and stimulating environment in which your child can learn and develop.

- To provide a happy, pleasurable and fun environment, which allows children to be children and build relationships with each other.
- To provide a relevant, broad and balanced curriculum with the ethos of the four purposes at the heart of the curricular choices.



- To develop your child's independence and well being
- To establish a good relationship between the school and parents

We consider this period to be of utmost importance in your child's life. This is the period when the foundations are set for the future.

If you as parents are not able to speak Welsh, don't worry! As a result of being immersed in the language from a young age they soon become fluent. Before Starting School

There are many ways that you can support your child's development:

- Give your child the opportunity to socialise with others, to learn to play
and share e.g. join a playgroup such as Cylch Ti a Fi
- Read stories to her/him.
- Sing nursery rhymes, songs and counting rhymes together
- Speak and listen to your child
- Give your child simple instructions to follow e.g. Get your bag.
- Include your child in everyday activities e.g. tidying up, cooking, shopping, matching socks/shoes
- Count everyday objects
- Watch Welsh programmes on S4C - Cyw
- Play games on the computer or iPad
- Encourage your child to go to the toilet independently, by undressing, flushing the toilet and wash and dry their hands
- Encourage your child to dress independently
- Encourage your child to recognise their name
- Talk to your child to prepare him/her for starting school
- Bring your child to visit the classroom and the staff. (Your child will receive an invitation with a date for your visit)

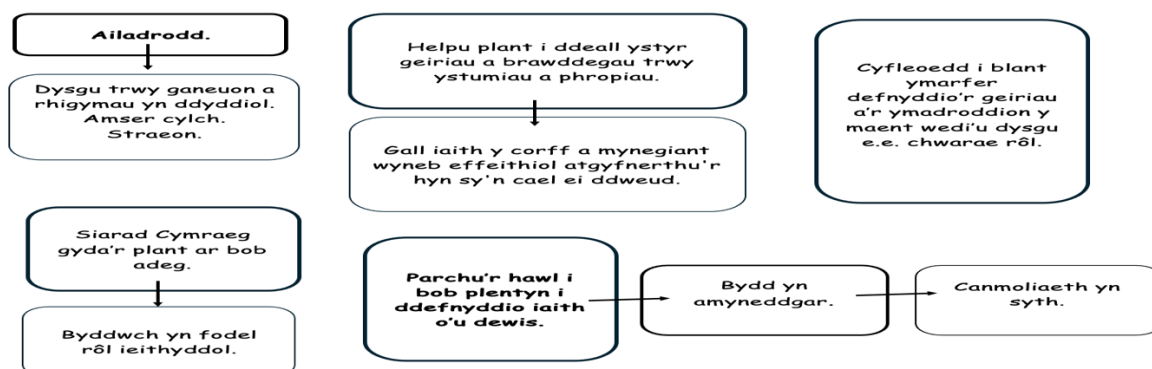
Amser Snac

Starting School

Nursery Hours

Morning Session: 8:50- 11:20a.m.

Afternoon Session: 12:50-3:20p.m.

Morning Session:

Enter at the gate on the Yard and escort your child to the classroom. Nursery staff will be ready to welcome the children from 8.35a.m. onwards.

Afternoon Session:

A member of staff will welcome your child at the gate on the Yard and walk them to the class.

Punctuality and Absences

It is important to ensure that your child arrives on time and is collected promptly. Please inform the school of any change in arrangements regarding the collection of your child at the end of the session.

In the case of absence, please inform the school at the earliest opportunity either by telephone, emailing the school or logging it on the 'Parentmail' app.

Collecting pupils

You will be asked to complete a form informing the school of the names of adults authorised to collect your child. Please inform the school of any change in arrangements regarding the collection of your child at the end of the session.

We do not release a child into another adult's care if we have not been notified beforehand of a change to the usual arrangement.

After school Club

Health Care/Medicines

You will need to inform us if your child suffers from any ill health, disease or allergy.

We would appreciate it if you try timing medication around school hours.

If this is not possible, you are welcome to come to school to give your child the

medication yourself or call into the office to fill out a medication form.

Staff will not administer medication without completing this form.

School Uniform

There is an official school uniform, the daily wearing of which is optional. However, on special occasions or stage performances, uniformity of dress is

required. (See the School Prospectus)

All article of clothing, bag and other belonging should be marked with the child's name so that mislaid items can be recovered easily.

Dressing Suitably for the Weather

Whatever the weather, we use the Little Yard, therefore it is important that your child is suitably dressed.

S/he will need a coat, gloves and hat in winter months and a sun hat when the weather improves.

REMEMBER TO APPLY SUN LOTION BEFORE COMING TO SCHOOL.

Spare clothes

On occasions children may have accidents or get wet/dirty and need to be changed. We ask that there is always a change of clothes and a packet of wet wipes in your Childs bag in case they are needed.

Physical Education

Your child will participate in weekly PE lessons. Please ensure that she/he is wearing black joggers and trainers on these days. Information regarding the days will be given at the beginning of the academic year.

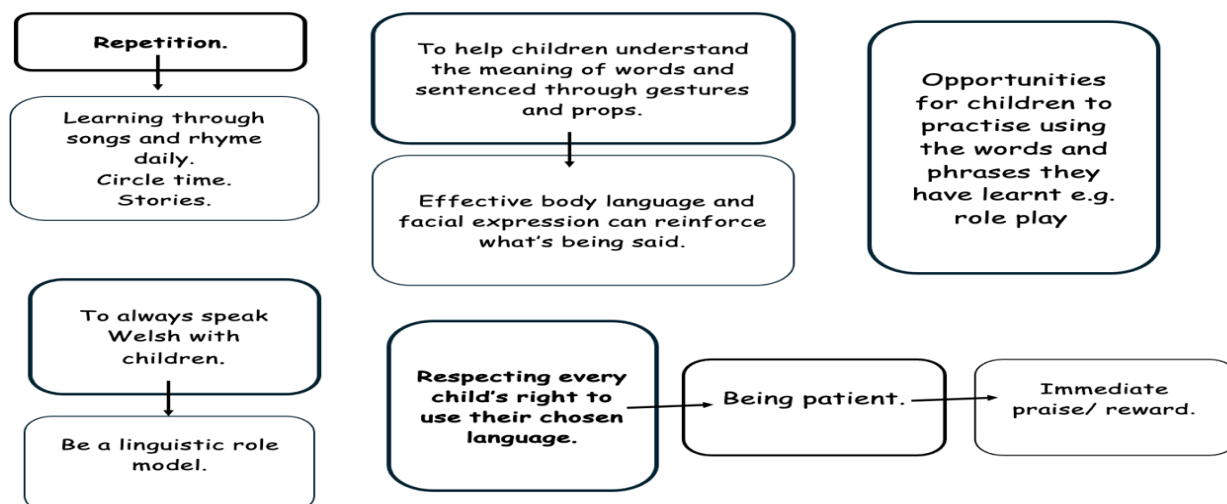
Snack time

Be patient! Allow sufficient time for your child to settle in at school. This time can vary from child to child. Naturally, some children will be tearful during the first few days and we appreciate that it can also be an anxious time

for parents. You are very welcome therefore, to contact the school to check that your child has settled and to put your mind at rest. If you have any general worries or questions, the class teacher will do her best to help. Staff are busy during the school day therefore the best time to talk with the teacher is before the session begins or at the end of the session.

Mae'r datblygiad a'r defnydd o iaith a chyfathrebu yn holl bwysig i ddysgu plant ifanc. Fe fydd pwyslais ar ddatblygu sgiliau gwranddo a siarad i osod sylfeini cadarn ar gyfer darllen ac ysgrifennu.

Fe fydd gweithgareddau'n cynnwys, chwarae rôl, mwynhau llyfrau, canu, chwarae gemau, gwneud marciau ac ysgrifennu cynnar.

Mathemateg a Rhifedd

Bydd eich plentyn yn cyfrif, didoli a chyfateb gwrthrychau, yn datblygu ei dd/dealltwriaeth o iaith fathemategol mewn cyd-destun, yn archwilio a chreu patrymau, yn dechrau archwilio priodweddau siapiau ac yn datblygu ei dd/dealltwriaeth o fesurau.

Fe fydd y gweithgareddau'n ymarferol iawn ac yn cynnwys chwarae gemau, chwarae rôl a chanu rhigymau rhif.

Dyniaethau

Bydd eich plentyn yn cael cyfleodd i drafod amseroedd a digwyddiadau sydd yn arbennig iddyn nhw. Byddant yn cymharu pethau yn y gorffennol a nawr. Cawn gyfle i archwilio'r amgylchedd a dysgu sut i'w ofalu amdani, ynghyd â adnabod pam mae llefydd yn bwysig iddyn nhw. Fe fydd gweithgareddau'n cynnwys edrych ar debygolrwydd a gwahaniaethau rhyngddyn nhw ei hun a'i ffrindiau, dysgu am ganlyniadau, mynegi ei hoffter/casineb, archwilio'r ardal leol; ymweld â'r parc a'r traeth, darganfod a dechrau gofyn cwestiynau syml a chynnig atebion synhwyrol wedi ei seilio ar brofiadau blaenorol.

Gwyddoniaeth a Thechnoleg

Bydd eich plentyn yn derbyn cyfleodd di-ri i fod yn chwilfrydig a dod o hyd atebion ynghyd a rhagfynegi. Byddant yn disgrifio ffenomena naturiol e.e. y tywydd ac enfys, ac archwilio grymoedd e.e. suddo ac arnofio. Byddant yn arsylwi ar bethau byw ac yn ceisio esbonio sut ydyn yn newid. Bydd eich plentyn hefyd yn cael cyfleodd i ddefnyddio dyfeisio digidol e.e. tabledi, teganau roboteg a chamêrau digidol.

Fe fydd gweithgareddau yn cynnwys defnyddio'i synhwyrau, archwilio, arbrofi, holi cwestiynau, enwi, dosbarthu a chreu pethau.

Iechyd a Lles

Bydd eich plentyn yn dysgu am ffordd o fyw iachus ac arferion gofal personol. Bydd eich plentyn yn dysgu amdano/i ei hunain a'i b/pherthynas ag eraill. Caiff ei h/annog i ddatblygu ei hunan-barch, ei g/chredoau p/ersonol a'i g/werthoedd moesol. Bydd yn datblygu dealltwriaeth bod gan bobl eraill anghenion, galluoedd, credoau a safbwyntiau gwahanol. Fe fydd eich plentyn yn datblygu ei sgiliau cydsymud, ei g/chydbwysedd, ei rheolaeth, ei sgiliau echddygol bras a manwl, a'i sgiliau llawdrinol.

Fe fydd gweithgareddau yn cynnwys mynegi teimladau, gweithio/chwarae ar y cyd, siarad am yr hyn sydd yn dda/ddrwg, yn gywir/anghywir, yn deg/annheg, trafod dathliadau, gofalu am yr amgylchedd. Fe fydd gweithgareddau'n cynnwys rhedeg, neidio, sgipio, reidio beiciau, taflu a dal offer mawr a bach, defnyddio siswrn, tynnu lluniau, peintio a sialco.

Celfyddydau Mynegiannol

Mae creadigrwydd yn hanfodol i ddysgu llwyddiannus. Mae bod yn greadigol yn galluogi plant i wneud cysylltiadau rhwng y meysydd dysgu ac felly'n ymestyn eu dealltwriaeth. Mae'r broses o fod yn greadigol yr un mor bwysig a'r gwaith orffenedig.

Mae'r maes yn cynnwys gweithgareddau fel peintio, tynnu lluniau, dylunio a gwneud modelau, arbrofi, canu, gwrandio ar a chreu cerddoriaeth, dawnsio a chwarae rôl.

Ymhlyg â'r cwricwlwm rhoddir pwyslais ar ddatblygu sgiliau ar draws y cwricwlwm. Bydd eich plentyn yn cael ei h/annog I gaffael, datblygu ymarfer a chymhwyso sgiliau meddwl, llythrennedd, ymhwysedd digidol a rhifedd ar draws y cwricwlwm. Trwy ddatblygu ei sgiliau ar draws y cwricwlwm bydd yn datblygu'n ddysgwr annibynnol a chyd-ddibynnol.

Pedagogy

In the nursery class we aim to excite and stimulate children's learning, improve their attainment and secure the best possible start for them. The curriculum and classroom environment will be planned and structured to enable your child to be curious and engaged. Your child will have the opportunity to explore his/her learning environment and to learn new skills in addition to developing skills previously acquired.

Active educational play supports your child's learning across the six Areas of Learning and Experience:



Languages, Literacy and Communication

The development and use of communication and language is at the heart of young children's learning. Emphasis will be on developing speaking and listening skills to lay sound foundations for reading and writing. Activities include role play, enjoying books, singing, playing games, making marks and pre-writing activities.

Mathematics and Numeracy

Your child will count, sort and match objects. He/she will develop his/her understanding of mathematical language in context, explore and create patterns, will begin to explore the properties of shape and develop his/her understanding of measures. Activities will be very practical and include playing games, rôle play, and singing number rhymes

Humanities

Your child will have opportunities to discuss times and events that are special to them. They might look at the past and compare things with how they are today. They will explore their environment and learn how to care for it and recognise why places are important to them. Activities will include looking at similarities/differences between themselves and others, learn about consequences, express their likes/dislikes, explore the local area, visit the park and the beach, discover and begin to ask simple questions and offer possible answers based on previous experiences.

Science and Technology

Your child will have ample opportunities to be curious and search for answers along with making predictions. They will begin to describe natural phenomena such as the weather and rainbows and explore the power of forces e.g. floating and sinking objects. They will observe living things and begin to explain how the change. They will also be given opportunities to use digital devices such as tablets, robotic toys

and digital cameras. Activities include exploring, experimenting, asking questions, identifying, classifying, and making things.

Health and Wellbeing

Your child will learn about having a healthy lifestyle and personal hygiene routines. They will learn about feelings and emotions and will be encouraged to develop his/her self-esteem, personal beliefs and moral values. He/she will develop an understanding that others have differing needs, abilities, beliefs and views. Your child will be developing their coordination, their balance, their control, their gross and fine motor skills, and his/her manipulative skills.

Expressive Arts

Creativity is fundamental to successful learning; it enables learners to become curious and creative individuals. Being creative enables children to make connections between one area of learning and another, and so extending their understanding. The process of creating is equally important as the end result. Activities include painting, drawing, modelling, experimenting, singing, listening to and making music, dance and imaginative play.

Emphasis is put on developing skills across the curriculum. Your child will be encouraged to acquire, develop, practice and apply thinking, communication, digital competency and numeracy skills across the curriculum. By developing their skills across the curriculum, they will become independent and interdependent learners.
