SUN SAFETY

The beginning of the Summer Term will, hopefully, herald the start of hot sunny days. However, with the sun come the dangers of sunburn, especially for younger children.

The protection of children is vitally important and there are a number of points schools can instigate to prevent the children getting sunburn.

- Minimise the time that children are exposed to the highest temperatures of the day by trying to hold outdoor activities before 11.00 a.m. and after 2.00 p.m.
- Encourage children to wear hats and appropriate clothing as well as using high protection sun cream.
- Involve parents and make sure they understand the importance of their children being protected from the sun.

The school has a Keeping Safe in the Sun Policy y. A reminder of the main elements of the policy are:

Protection – providing an environment that enables pupils and staff to stay safe on sunny days.

Education – learning about sun safety to influence behaviour.

Collaboration – working with parents, governors and the wider community to reinforce sun safety awareness.



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
