I am sure that you will have heard on the news over the weekend of the uncertainty surrounding the last week, July 20 – 24 and whether the school will be open or closed. Some counties have already confirmed that the extra week will not go ahead. We are still waiting to hear from Swansea County. Once confirmation is received, we will inform you of the decision.

Again. I thank you for your patience.

If you have confirmed your child's return to school in the summer term, you will hear from the office by the end of the day. I kindly requested that ALL enquiries relating to your child's groups or related to the reopening of the school, that they be sent to the **school email** and if possible, within office hours.

On the day your child returns- the focus of the day will be:

- Wellbeing
- An outdoor lesson – School uniform not required. Please wear trainers.
- Digital competence
- A small check in with 'number' and Welsh reading

Summer term sessions will give pupils the opportunity to re-connect with the school and its teachers and to transition to the new class.

Remember, the other virtual **lessons** will continue through HWB until the end of term and will be available to all.

The virtual **meetings** will begin on the 29th of June. **These are also available to all.** Teachers will set a timetable for the children. This will be communicated via your children's mail on HWB (pupils Yr 2 – 6) or by email to parents for the younger children. The focus of these live sessions will be wellbeing, checking to see if help is needed with any tasks, and to support the children to speak Welsh. They will follow the Cynllun Clonc scheme. This is the first time we have used this new teaching style, and I'm sure it will take a few sessions for everyone to get used to the new approach. **Remember to return your home /school agreement to the school email.**
