11:00 – Two minute silence

To honour the service and sacrifice of the Second World War generation and reflect on the devastating impact Covid-19 has had on so many lives across the world. Some may wish to stand at their windows, step outside their homes while remaining distanced from others, watch the broadcast on television, or simply sit in a quiet moment of reflection.

11:15 – Royal British Legion Livestream

Sharing stories and memories from those who served and sacrificed during the Second World War, and recognising the difficulties people are experiencing today.
