SWANSEA Council is proposing to build a new school building for YGG Tirdeunaw on land that is presently part of YGG Bryntawe, Heol Gwrosydd, Penlan Swansea.

This new facility would replace the existing YGG Tirdeunaw on Heol Ddu, Mynyddbach with new fit-for-purpose accommodation suitable for 21st century teaching and learning.

YGG Tirdeunaw

YGG Tirdeunaw is a Welsh-medium primary school that presently provides 420 full time places and 60 nursery places. However, the building which is part of the former Daniel James Secondary School is no longer suitable for the increasing pupil numbers.

A statutory consultation process has been undertaken to enlarge the size of the school to provide 525 full time and 75 nursery places and provide suitable accommodation for the pupils and staff.

Our Aim

The overall objective of this project is to provide new fit-for-purpose accommodation suitable for 21st century teaching and learning and increase the number of Welsh-medium primary places available in the locality.

The Education Benefits

The proposed development would:

- Create quality teaching and learning facilities for 525 full-time pupils
- Create appropriate on-site Nursery provision
- Provide suitable provision for a Flying Start facility that will provide 24 pre-school places for 2 year olds.
- Ensure that pupils benefit from classrooms opening out directly onto suitable outdoor learning and play areas
- Deliver classrooms of appropriate size that provide a learning environment fit for a 21st century school.

The Design Proposal

The proposal is to build a two storey primary school with associated recreational space. As part of the new school development more suitable parking facilities for staff and parents would also be created and there will be improvements to the traffic arrangements which will be an added benefit for the existing YGG Bryntawe school and community use at the Penlan site.

Community benefits

The Council is committed to supporting local firms and creating jobs for local people. During the proposed works, the Council will use local suppliers, where possible, for materials and products.

Contractors will be encouraged to employ local workers and offer work experience to unemployed young people.
