Welcome back!

It's great to welcome all the pupils back to us after the long summer break. A special welcome especially to all the new nursery class pupils who have joined the school.

We are pleased to welcome back Mrs Kelly Jones and Mrs Rhian Hiley (nee Owen) both of whom have returned from maternity leave. We would particularly like to congratulate Mrs Rhian Hiley who got married over the summer holidays. We extend our best wishes to her and her husband and wish them well in the future.

It is also nice to welcome three new members of staff to the school, Mrs Rhian Haden, who is employed as a part-time admin officer at the school office supporting Mrs Gayle Hughes, Mrs Catherine Jones, a part-time teacher in Years 5, 6 and Nursery Class and Mrs Rhian Malpass who is employed as a part-time assistant in the Reception / Year 1 Class.

Personal details and consent forms

Please could you check your child's personal details on the attached form and complete the appropriate consent forms as soon as possible. If your circumstances / telephone number changes during the year, please inform the office to ensure our records are up-to-date.

School Drop Off and Pick up procedures

The school gates open at 8.30 a.m. Please drop your child off at the side entrance gate. All pupils are supervised by staff until the school day starts at 8.50 a.m. Parents of **Nursery pupils** are permitted to access the school yard and escort their children to the nursery yard. You are welcome to stay with your children until the school bell rings.

Parents of new **Reception Class** children are encouraged to drop their children at the gate however if your child is anxious at the beginning you are welcome to accompany them onto

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the yard during the first few days/weeks until they feel more confident and assured. The reception staff will be on the yard to assist.

Parents are asked to complete a form informing the school of the names of adults authorised to collect their children. Parents are expected to notify the school if there are any changes to the arrangements for collecting their children. We do not release a child into another adult's care if we have not been notified beforehand of a change to the usual arrangement.

New online payments - 'sQuid'

The new online system for paying for school dinners 'sQuid' is now operational. The system also allows pupils to choose from the menu but this is not up and running yet. The company is dealing with the issue and a solution is expected very soon. Thanks for your patience! The cost of school lunches from September 2017 is £ 2.25 per day or £ 11.25 for the whole week.

Welcome meetings for parents

Welcome Meetings for the parents of pupils in Yrs 1-6 will be held on the 11th September at 5.30p.m onwards. The meetings are an opportunity for you as parents to meet your child's new teacher, familiarise yourselves with the curriculum and class organisation as well as to ask any questions you may have.

Attendance and Punctuality

Regular attendance at school and arriving on time is of the utmost importance. If your child is unwell please contact the school on the first morning, either by telephone or via 'Parent Mail' in order to inform us of the illness. If we do not hear from you we will contact you via a text message or by phone on the first morning of absence. If the school does not receive an explanation for your child's absence, the absence will be recorded as an unauthorised absence. If your child is absent without explanation we will also contact the Education Welfare Officer.

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Pupil punctuality is also important and arriving late often impacts negatively on a child's education. Punctuality is also monitored by the school and the LA. If a child is regularly late the school will notify the Education Welfare Officer.

*If you need to request leave of absence, could you please complete the relevant form, which is available from the school office and return it to the school for approval by the Head Teacher. **Taking school holidays during term time is discouraged. All absences due to holidays will be recorded as unauthorised.***

School Uniform

We feel that school uniform promotes a sense of belonging and pride. Your child is encouraged to wear the school's official uniform. You can buy the uniform from Nash Sports, Sketty; J and S Leisurewear, Ty Coch; Bergoni, Llansamlet; Tesco direct – online.

Sports

We ask that the children in the Junior department (KS2) bring a sports kit (t-shirt / polo shirt, shorts and trainers) when there are games lessons, and bring a t-shirt / polo shirt for gymnastics. Pupils should not come to school in their sports kit - they need to change for these lessons.

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After School Clubs

The after school clubs will start on the week beginning the 18th September. The timetable will be available at the end of this week. The clubs are open to pupils from Years 1-6.

Breakfast Club

The breakfast club is open to all school pupils each morning from 7.50am to 8.50am. There is a 50p charge for each pupil attending the breakfast club between 7.50am and 8.20am. During this period children can use the school hall to enjoy cereal, toast and juice. Supervision of pupils in the hall and the yard is ensured during this time and continues until registration time at 8.50 a.m.
