Return to school for Keys Stage 2 – Years 3 – 6



All pupils from years 3 to 6 will **return fully on Monday 15th March**. Key stage 2 staff will have a planning and preparing day on Friday March 12th to ensure that the return to school for KS2 pupils is a safe one. I am sure that pupils and teachers alike are looking forward to face to face teaching again. Covid 19 measures are still in place for all pupils including regular

handwashing, social distancing, bubbles and all the other measures that are in place to keep the school community safe. Please **remember to wear a face mask** at drop off and collection times. 3.10pm for Years 3 and 4, 3.20pm for years 5 and 6. If you are exempt from wearing a face mask, please let the office know. It is through our combined effort we can try to control possible covid infections from affecting the wellbeing and education our children.

May I remind parents that you must not send your child to school if your child or anyone in the household has any of the following symptoms:

- A new or continuous cough
- A high temperature
- Loss of taste or smell
- Inform the **school immediately** if anyone in the household tests positive for Covid 19.

Breakfast Club / Afterschool club

Breakfast club will recommence on Monday the 8th of March. Breakfast club opens at 7.50am. It will cost £1.50. Whilst every effort will be made to maintain distinct bubbles within the hall using a seating plan and screens, it may be, that should a positive case be identified in the Breakfast club that **all** attendees will need to self-isolate. Therefore, I urge you to only use the breakfast club if you really need to. Afterschool club will not reopen for the time being. This is under continuous review.
