Return to school



It has been wonderful to welcome the foundation phase back to school this week. Everyone has settled very well and quickly back into their routines. Again, I would like to remind you that we all must play our part in the control of the virus. Although there is definitely light at the end of the tunnel with the roll out of a successful vaccination program, we are not out of the woods just yet.

Staff have worked very hard to try to make the school as safe as possible to try to control the spread of the virus, but we cannot totally mitigate and say with all assurance that there will be no covid positive test in school. I would like to thank ALL staff that have volunteered to take part in and engage with the Lateral Flow Testing process. This is an intrusive medical procedure that staff will need to carry out twice a week. By doing so, staff are providing another way in which we are placing the health, safety and wellbeing of the school community as a priority. A positive result will obviously have an affect on the bubble / bubbles.

May I remind parents that you must not send your child to school if your child or anyone in the household has any of the following symptoms:

- A new or continuous cough
 - A high temperature
 - Loss of taste or smell
- Inform the **school immediately** if anyone in the household tests positive for Covid 19.
