O 13eg Rhagfyr 2017, rhaid i unrhyw un sy'n byw yn Abertawe sydd o oedran gweithio sydd angen gwneud cais newydd am unrhyw un o'r budd-daliadau a restrir uchod hawlio Credyd Cynhwysol.

Nid yw Credyd Cynhwysol yn gwahaniaethu rhwng manteision yn y gwaith a budd-daliadau y tu allan i'r gwaith. Felly, bydd pobl sy'n hawlio budd-daliadau mewn gwaith ar incwm isel yn gymwys i gael Prydau Ysgol am Ddim.

Ar hyn o bryd, mae rheoliadau Prydau Ysgol am Ddim yn caniatáu i deuluoedd yng Nghymru sy'n derbyn Credyd Cyffredinol i fod yn gymwys i gael Prydau Ysgol am Ddim i'w plant. Mae hyn yn cynnwys teuluoedd a oedd yn anghymwys yn flaenorol (e.e. y rhai a fyddai wedi bod yn gymwys ar gyfer Credyd Treth Gwaith).

Os ydych yn gwneud gais am Credyd Cynhwysol o 13 Rhagfyr 2017, rydym yn eich annog i wneud cais am Brydau Ysgol am Ddim hefyd. I wneud cais, ewch i www.swansea.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals

Hyd yn oed os nad yw'ch plentyn am gael cinio am ddim, mae'n bwysig eich bod yn gwneud cais am Brydau Ysgol am Ddim os ydynt yn gymwys. Mae'r ysgol yn derbyn cyllid o ganlyniad i nifer y plant yn yr ysgol sy'n gymwys i gael Prydau Ysgol am Ddim. Mae'r cyllid hwn yn caniatáu i ystod o fesurau gael eu rhoi ar waith sy'n anelu at godi cyrhaeddiad, cynyddu cyfleoedd a chefnogi pob dysgwr.

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Free School Meals Eligibility

As you will be aware Universal Credit is a benefit that has replaced the benefits listed below:

- Housing Benefit
- Income Support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit
- Working Tax Credit

From 13th December 2017, anyone living in Swansea who is of working age that needs to make a new claim for **any** of the benefits listed above will have to claim Universal Credit.

Universal Credit does not distinguish between in-work and out-of-work benefits. People claiming in-work benefits on low incomes will therefore become eligible for Free School Meals.

At present, Free School Meals regulations allow families in Wales who receive Universal Credit to qualify for Free School Meals for their children. This includes families who were previously ineligible (e.g. those who would have been eligible for Working Tax Credit).

If you make a claim for Universal Credit from 13th December 2017, we encourage you to also make a claim for Free School Meals. To make a claim please visit www.swansea.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals

Even if your child does not wish to have the free meals, it is important that you apply for Free School Meals if they are eligible. The school receives funding as a result of the number of children in the school who are eligible for Free School Meals. This funding allows a range of measures to be put in place aimed at raising attainment, increasing opportunities and supporting all learners.
